Proposed Bicycle and Walking Path
On Former NYCRR Railbed in Manchester

A proposal has been brought to the Village Council to construct a shared-use walking and bicycle path along the former NYCRR railbed within the Village limits. The current railbed is owned by the Village of Manchester, and the proposed project will improve the railbed into a two-mile finished path connecting the Leonard Preserve to the Village Hall through Chi-Bro Park. The project will include a finished railbed surface, a connecting shared-use pedestrian bridge over the Mill Pond, signage, rest areas and other facilities.

The proposed project will seek available non-motorized transportation funding from a variety of county, State and Federal sources. The proposed design and funding will be presented at the meeting. Public comments and input are requested. We encourage all area residents with an interest in this proposed project to attend this meeting.
